**The South Washington Watershed District is seeking members for the Citizens Advisory Committee.**

As part of the SWWD Watershed Management Plan, the SWWD must provide opportunity for public involvement and input. This will be accomplished through the establishment of a Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC). The SWWD is seeking individuals from the member cities (Woodbury, Cottage Grove, St. Paul Park, Newport, Lake Elmo, Oakdale, Afton, and Grey Cloud Island Township) to review and comment on the SWWD Annual work plan and budget.

The first meeting of the CAC is tentatively scheduled for sometime in July. It is anticipated that there will be 1-2 meetings, with a total time commitment of 2-4 hours. The CAC will continue to meet on a regular basis providing input to the SWWD Board regarding watershed activities. CAC meetings will be held on a quarterly basis or as needed by the direction of the committee.
