Description	Grant administration and coordination for the CWF FY2013 Colby Water ReUse grant. All administration and coordination will be completed by SWWD Water Resource Specialist John Loomis. No grant funds will be used for this initiative. Rather, funding is provided through local funds. This initiative includes development and execution of a funding agreement with Washington County and City of Woodbury outlining funding participitation of each entity and detailing operation and maintenance and inspection requirements. The City of Woodbury will ultimately be responsible for ensuring operation and maintenance of the completed water re-use systems for the expected lifetime (25 yrs) of the BMPs. These documents will be provided to BWSR for their review and approval and will provide necessary project assurances as outlined in the BWSR Grant Administration Manual.

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Grant Activity - Eagle Valley	Golf Course Re-use System				
Description	The proposed project includes pumping water from an existing retention basin (City pond CD-P47.1) to the Eagle Valley Golf Course's irrigation pond. This nutrient laden water which would otherwise drain to Colby Lake will then be used for irrigation of the golf course, largely reducing the golf course's current reliance on groundwater for irrigation. When the irrigation pond is at capacity, water pumped out of CD-P47.1 will be diverted to existing pond CD-P47.5 (upstream of CD-P47.1) which will result in recirculation of water through several additional ponds as a means to provide additional treatment. Necessary project assurances will be developed as part of the Coordination/Administration Initiative attached to this project.

Actual Results	The anticipated budget for the Eagle Valley system was \$283,400.00. The lump sum bid price for the system was \$270,000.00. The system is nearly complete. The water intake, pump station, and irrigation/overflow system connections have all been completed. We anticipate that some restoration and system modifications may be necessary in the spring once the system becomes operational. Washington County has documented expenditure of the first 50% of grant funds and has requested the subsequent 40% payment from SWWD, consistent with the Cooperative Construction Agreement. SWWD has issued payment to the County for the 40% distribution. The project is wrapping up and we expect to have final cost details in early 2015. We will update reporting at that time and submit a final report.

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Grant Activity - Prestwick Golf Co	ourse Reuse System
Description	Existing City ponds CD-P58 and CD-P58.1 will be modified to provide one contiguous reservoir which will recieve water via the existing drainage system. A new pump station and related infrastructure will deliver water from the new CD-P58/58.1 reservoir to the existing golf course irrigation system. When irrigation is unnecessary, water will be diverted to other existing ponds within the golf course with high infiltration rates. The new reuse system will result in extensive irrigation of the golf course with nutrient laden water that would otherwise drain to Bailey Lake in place of pumped groundwater. Necessary project assurances will be developed as part of the Coordination/Administration Initiative attached to this project.

Actual Results	The anticipated budget for the Prestwick system was \$453,050.00. The lump sum bid for the system was \$380,000.00. To date, the system is approximately half complete. Additional system connections, grading, and restoration will be necessary in the Spring prior to activating the system. Washington County has documented expenditure of the first 50% of grant funds and has requested the subsequent 40% payment from SWWD, consistent with the Cooperative Construction Agreement. SWWD has issued payment to the County for the 40% distribution. The project is wrapping up and we expect to have final cost details in early 2015. We will update reporting at that time and submit a final report.
