6. 2019 Budget Preliminary Certification

• Administrator Moore provided the Board an overview of the draft 2019 budget. The 2019 overall budget is flat compared to 2018. The levy will increase 5.9% with additional funding for the new SWWD office space in 2019. Preliminary stormwater utility fees show a decrease of \$9 for the 75% fee and the 25% fee is flat. A motion was made by Manager ChapdeLaine to preliminary certify the 2019 levy of \$1,142,061 to Washington County. Manager Madigan seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

10. Armstrong Lake Sub-Watershed Analysis Report

Andy Schilling presented the Armstrong Lake Sub-Watershed Analysis report. The analysis
identifies five projects to improve water quality. After discussion, a motion was made by Manager
Madigan to accept the Armstrong Lake Sub-Watershed Analysis report and authorized staff to
include it as a guidance document to the SWWD Watershed Management Plan. Manager
ChapdeLaine seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

11. Growing Explorers Learning Center, Permit #18-001

 After discussion, a motion was made by Manager Johnson to approve Permit #18-001 for the Growing Explorers Learning Center in Lake Elmo. Manager ChapdeLaine seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

12. Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources Watershed Based Funding Grant Agreement.

• The SWWD received a FY 2019 State of Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources Watershed Based Funding Grant for \$78,760.00. After discussion, a motion was made by Manager Johnson to approve the FY 2019 State of Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources Watershed Based Funding Grant Agreement.
