design moving and stick to the timeline Staff approved additional services for Houston Engineering—geotechnical data collection and survey to support easement description development. Both services were identified as potentially necessary but not authorized under the existing task order for the project. Total cost for the additional services is \$23,153. The revised cost of the task order with additional services is \$59,905. A motion was made by Manager ChapdeLaine to approve the McQuade additional services with Houston Engineering for up to a total cost of \$59,905. Manager Madigan seconded.
