Consistent with MN Rule 8410, each Municipality in the District must maintain a local water management plan and local controls that are in conformance with SWWD's Watershed Management Plan and Rules. SWWD relies on this legal partnership to satisfy some requirements of MCMs 4 and 5. All stormwater entering SWWD's owned and operated system originates and is delivered by municipal MS4s. Because all inflows into SWWD's system come from municipal MS4s, we expect them to meet all permit requirements. SWWD does assist those municipalities with ESC inspections as needed. Violations identified during inspections are followed up on by City staff.
